

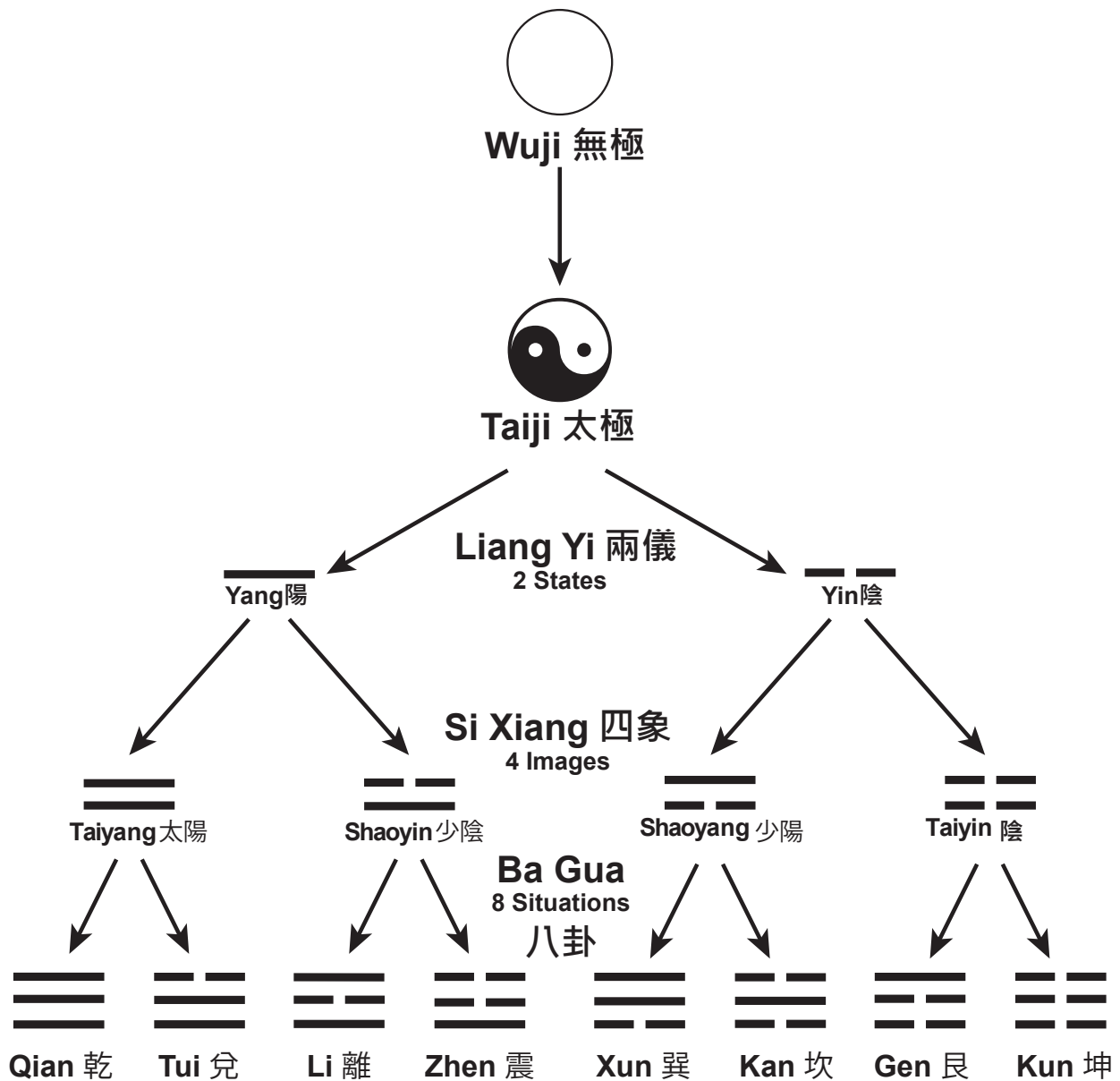
Yijing Poem 易經繫辭

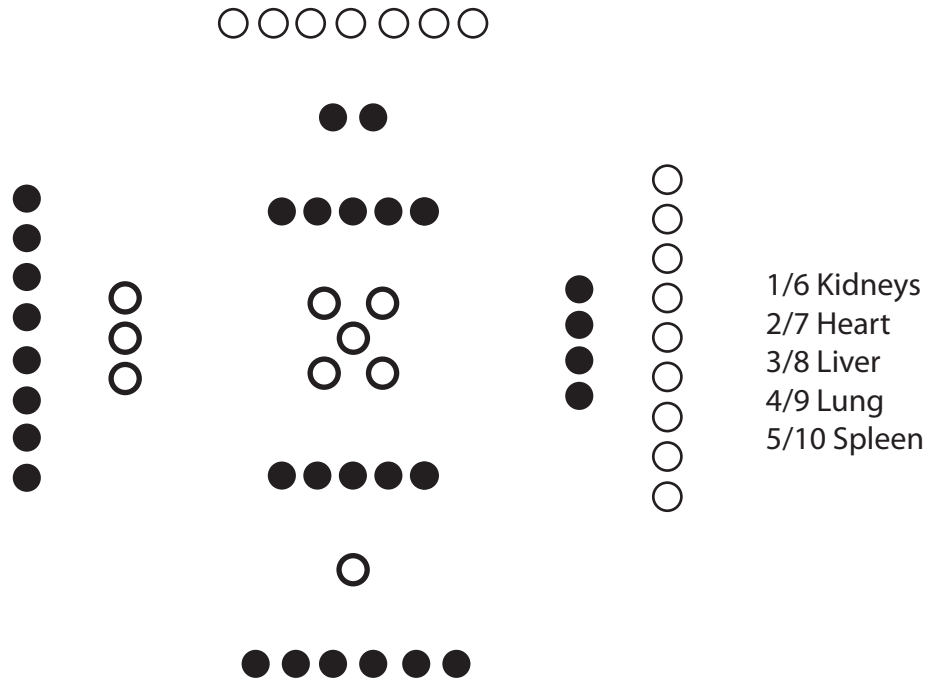

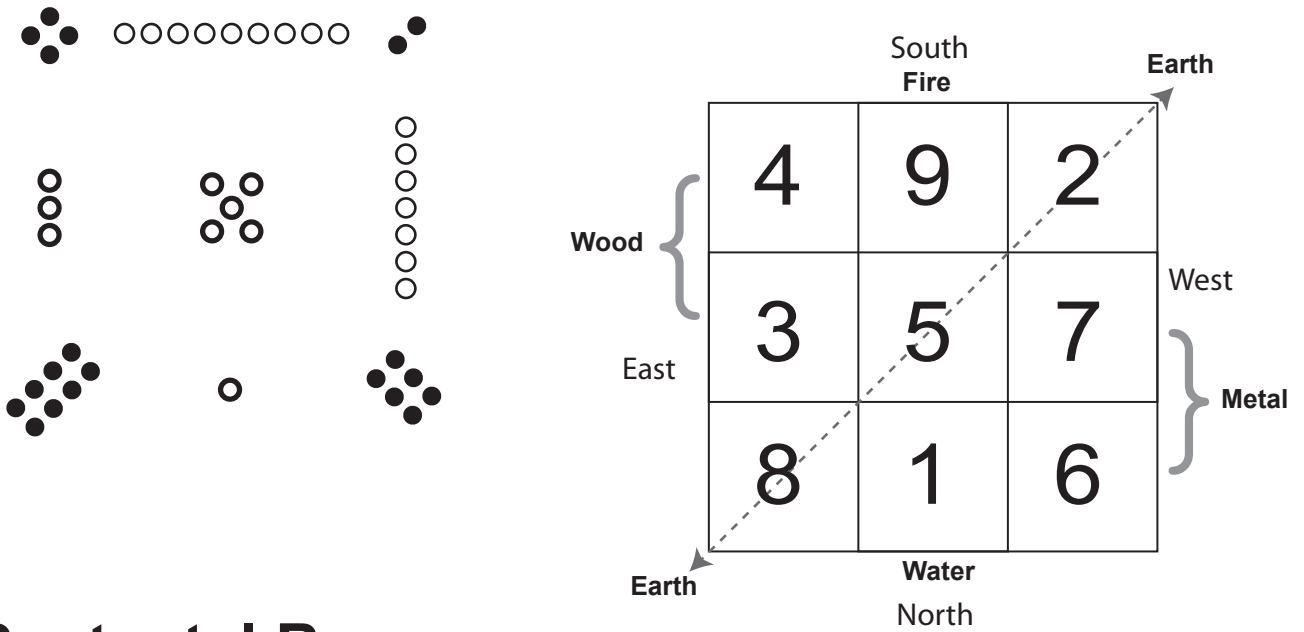
